Fife COVID-19 Health and Social Care HOUSEHOLD MEMBER Testing Flow Chart



Has the household member had:

- new fever/high temp OR
- new, continuous cough, OR
- Loss of / change in sense of smell or taste

A new continuous cough is where you have a new cough that's persistent & lasted for an hour, or, have had 3 or more episodes of coughing in 24 hours, or, are coughing more than usual

A high temperature is feeling hot to the touch on your chest or back. You may feel warm, cold or shivery Do not meet clinical criteria. No requirement for testing or self-isolation.



Household member should follow national guidance on isolation (10 days post onset of symptoms).

Staff member should follow national guidance on household isolation (stay off for 14 days from date of onset of household member's symptoms), and will not be tested as beyond 5 days test results are difficult to interpret.
