- Clear access to a sink

- Access to a clean and clear working area
- A flat solid surface for equipment
- Good lighting
- Un-caged pets to be removed from the room
- A Smoke free room during the visit



Your health care professional will need

- Access to your community care plan or home care plan, if you have one
- You to inform them of any current infection
- Details of your medical history
