

Appendix 7 – Responsibilities of the ICC

The ICC Must:

1. Set and monitor local and national priorities related to infection control.
2. Coordinate and monitor infection control activity across the whole health community served by the IPCT.
3. Evaluate the impact of infection on service delivery.
4. Approve the development and monitor implementation of an annual programme of work associated with infection control.
5. Ensure compliance with national standards through development and implementation of robust monitoring systems across the health community served by the IPCT.
6. Support the delivery of governance and health and safety activities related to infection control.
7. Direct the development of the infection control policy, SOPs, guidelines and standards.
8. Receive and review risk management reports related to infection control.
9. Receive and review reports and minutes from infection control projects and subgroups of the ICC.
