Appendix 7 – Responsibilities of the ICC

The ICC Must:

- 1. Set and monitor local and national priorities related to infection control.
- 2. Coordinate and monitor infection control activity across the whole health community served by the IPCT.
- 3. Evaluate the impact of infection on service delivery.
- 4. Approve the development and monitor implementation of an annual programme of work associated with infection control.
- 5. Ensure compliance with national standards through development and implementation of robust monitoring systems across the health community served by the IPCT.
- 6. Support the delivery of governance and health and safety activities related to infection control.
- 7. Direct the development of the infection control policy, SOPs, guidelines and standards.
- 8. Receive and review risk management reports related to infection control.
- 9. Receive and review reports and minutes from infection control projects and subgroups of the ICC.
