Record Results

Post 1: After you take an LFD test, we need you to record your results. Recording both positive and negative results allows us to track the presence of the virus in your community, so we can keep everyone safe and help reduce the risk of new covid strains spreading. Register your results at covidtest.scot

Post 2: We need you to take 2 LFD tests every week, even if you have no symptoms of coronavirus. Record your result online, even if it's negative, at covidtest.scot


