Appendix 5 – Responsibilities of an ICD

The ICDs:

- Should have allocated specific sessions for infection control across NHS Fife
- Will usually be a Consultant in Medical Microbiology
- Will be responsible to the Chief Executive of NHS Fife
- Should be trained in all aspects of infection control

The ICDs must:

- 1. Provide strategic leadership in conjunction with the ICM and SIPCN for infection prevention and control to NHS Fife
- 2. Provide specialist expert advice on the control of infection for the ICC and NHS Fife.
- 3. Adopt national evidence-based guidance in order to ensure that patients are treated according to best practice.
- 4. Ensure adequate infection control advice is available to all NHS Fife staff at all times.
