# Walking aids and equipment include:

- Walking Frames
- > Crutches
- > Sticks
- Bath Aids
- > Toilet Aids
- Chairs
- Kitchen Trolleys

When you or your relative no longer require the equipment you will be able to:

- return it to a local Recycling Centre
- make an appointment for the equipment to be collected

The equipment can then be refurbished and used again if it is in good condition.
