


# Ready to make testing a part of your routine?

Campaign toolkit for community groups

Regular testing helps keep everyone safer.

To help promote community testing within your group, we have created a range of assets to download and use.



#### // Key messages

#### Why regular testing matters

Taking part in regular testing when people don't have symptoms helps to protect our loved ones and others around us.

Around 1 in 3 people with COVID-19 don't have symptoms. By getting tested regularly we can find out if we have the virus without knowing it and avoid passing it on.

Even after vaccination, we should still test regularly. Although vaccines reduce the risk of infection, it's still possible to catch the virus and pass it on to others without knowing.

Everyone in Scotland is being encouraged to make regular testing part of their routine. In addition, we should test before socialising or heading out to busy places.

Lateral Flow Device (LFD) tests are free, quick and easy to use. LFD testing is available at Community Testing sites throughout Fife. Home testing kits are also available to pick up at testing sites and participating community pharmacies, or can be ordered for delivery to the door, for anyone preferring to test at home.

# Visiting a Community Testing site

Community Testing sites are safe and secure, with sites open throughout Fife seven days a week, and there's no need to book. Just drop-in during opening hours.

We now use nose-only testing at Community Testing sites, so there is no need to take a throat swab. The test takes under a minute, with results available within 15 minutes.

Friendly and knowledgeable staff offer support throughout each visit, providing help to:

- Register for the test
- Guide you through the test
- Record test results for you

You'll also receive our 'What to Expect' booklet, which gives information on testing and what to do if you test positive.

If your LFD test is positive, then you can access a confirmatory PCR test on-site, without having to make a separate appointment. You can also access a range of different types of support at our sites, from a food package to financial advice.

#### Where to get tested


There are four fixed Community Testing sites at:


- Glebe Centre, Kirkcaldy
- Leys Park Road, Dunfermline
- Maxwell Centre, Cowdenbeath
- Parkgate Centre, Rosyth

In addition, there are five mobile community testing units which visit villages and towns across the Kingdom, making it easier for people to access testing locally. We select where mobile testing sites should be located based on the latest Public Health data, that might include higher positive COVID-19 cases in a particular area or lower than expected testing uptake.




